





The Older Adult Behavior Checklist for Ages 60 and Above (OABC 60-90) was completed by Informant6 Informant6, FirstName's family friend, to obtain Informant6 Informant6's perception of FirstName's adaptive functioning, substance use, and problems.

On the OABC/60 and Above - Adaptive Functioning Scale Scores, FirstName's scores on all rated scales were in the normal range. No score was calculated for the Spouse/Partner scale because FirstName had not lived with a partner in the previous 2 months. FirstName's score on the Personal Strengths scale was in the normal range. Informant6 Informant6 reported FirstName's marital status as never been married.

Informant6 Informant6 reported that FirstName used no tobacco in the past 2 months. Informant6 Informant6 also reported that FirstName consumed no alcoholic drinks in the past 2 months. Informant6 Informant6 reported that FirstName had not been drunk. Informant6 Informant6 reported that FirstName used no drugs for non-medical purposes during the past 2 months.

On the OABC 60-90 problem scales, FirstName's Total Problems score was in the normal range for men aged 76. Scores on all rated syndrome scales were in the normal range. FirstName's scores on the Critical Items are listed in the box below. The sum of FirstName's scores on the Critical Items was in the normal range.

On the OABL/60 and Above - DSM-Oriented Scales, FirstName's scores on the Depressive Problems, Anxiety Problems, Somatic Problems, Dementia Problems and Psychotic Problems scales were in the normal range. FirstName's score on the Antisocial Personality Problems scale was in the borderline clinical range (93rd to 97th percentile). FirstName's score in the borderline clinical range suggests that the DSM should be consulted to determine whether FirstName might meet diagnostic criteria for disorders characterized by problems included on that scale.

### Critical Items

In addition to the scale scores, it is important to consider scores on individual problem items. Because they may raise particular challenges for management, it is especially important to note the problems listed below that were reported with scores of 1 or 2. Look at comments made by the informant on the form in relation to these problems to obtain more information about risks associated with the problems and the contexts in which the problems occur.
